COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 781,  
L. D. 2237, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Powers  
of the Cobbossee Watershed District and  
Providing Funds for the Acquisition of Dams."

Amend said Bill in section 3 by inserting  
in the 13th line (11th line of L.D.) after the  
underlined words and punctuation "Torsey Pond,"  
the underlined words and punctuation 'Lake  
Annabessacook,'

Further amend said Bill in section 4  
by striking out in the 6th line (same in L.D.)  
the underlined figure "5" and inserting in  
place thereof the underlined figure '10'

Further amend said Bill in section 5 by  
striking out the 3rd sentence from the end and  
inserting in place thereof the following:  
'If a town or city does not accept this Act, the  
district shall not include the territory and  
inhabitants of said municipality and said  
municipality shall pay no assessments and shall  
have no right to be represented by a trustee  
on the board.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all  
of section 6.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to include  
Lake Annabessacook in the watershed; to change the  
valuation of property and land from every 5 years  
to every 10 years and to leave in the statutes, the  
law which states that the district shall not include  
the territory and inhabitants of said municipality.  
This amendment is also removing the \$20,000 appropria-  
tion.
