



## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 106TH LEGISLATURE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 1768, L. D. 2240, Bill, "AN ACT Providing Funds for Marine Research."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, funds are urgently needed to transfer the conduct of marine research from Glouc ester to Boothbay; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally needed to provide such research at the earliest possible time; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last 3 lines before the Statement of Fact (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'All Other

\$200,000

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
