COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1771,  
L. D. 2243, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the  
Regulation and Control of Dogs."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything  
after the amending clause and before the  
Statement of Fact and inserting in place thereof  
the following:

'§3458. Local regulations

Municipalities of this State are empowered  
to adopt or retain more stringent ordinances,  
laws or regulations dealing with the subject  
matter of this chapter. Any less restrictive  
municipal ordinances, laws or regulations  
dealing with the subject matter of this chapter  
are invalid and of no force and superseded by  
this chapter.

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to  
clarify provisions relating to local regulation  
and control of dogs.
