SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1774, L. D. 2246, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to a State-wide Food Stamp Program."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. Authorization. The county commissioners of the several counties shall be authorized to borrow in anticipation of federal revenue sharing funds or budget for the year 1975 an amount to operate and administer such a program.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering section 2 to be section 3.

It is the intent of this amendment to enable the county commissioners of the several counties to acquire funds for the 1975 Food Stamp Program.
