**AN ACT to Repeal Reference in Law that University of Maine Officers
and Employees are Unclassified Employees of State of Maine.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 711, sub-§ 8, repealed and replaced. Subsection 8 of section 711 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 11 of chapter 504 of the public laws of 1969, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

8. Unorganized territory, vocational schools and state institutions. Officers and employees of the unorganized territory school system and the teachers and principals of the school systems in state vocational schools and state institutions;

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is reflected in the title. The Attorney General agrees that University of Maine employees are not state employees.
