COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1781,
L. D. 2253, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Absentee
Voting by Persons Serving Sentences in Jails
and Penal Institutions."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the
title and inserting in place thereof the following:
'AN ACT Relating to Absentee Voting by Persons
Incarcerated by Civil Process.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out
everything after the enacting clause and before
the Statement of Fact (same in L.D.) and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 21, § 1, sub-§ 1, amended. The
last sentence of subsection 1 of section 1 of
Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended to
read as follows:

A person who is serving a sentence in a jail or
penal institution is not an absentee voter,
unless he is incarcerated by civil process.'
