AN ACT to Define Registered Nurses Exempt under Cosmetology Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 1552, sub-§ 3, amended. Subsection 3 of section 1552 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

3. Registered nurses. Registered nurses and all persons authorized to perform patient care.
