SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 1788,
L. D. 2260, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and
Inconsistencies in the Motor Vehicle Laws."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end before
the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 11. R. S., T. 29, §999, amended.
The first paragraph of section 999 of Title 29
of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 65
of the public laws of 1967 and as amended by
chapter 650 of the public laws of 1973, is amended
to read as follows:

In addition to the requirements of this chapter,
motorcycles and motor driven cycles shall be
operated on the highway ~~with-a-lighted-headlamp
on-when-in-motion-and~~ in such manner that no more
than 2 such vehicles shall be operated abreast
within the same lane of operation.

Sec. 12. Effective date. Section 11 of this
Act shall become effective 91 days after adjournment
of the Legislature.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to delete
the language in Title 29, section 999 which was
added by chapter 650 of the public laws of 1973.
