**RESOLVE, Providing Funds for Construction of a Fire Pond at Frenchboro
Long Island Plantation, Hancock County.**

**Fire Pond at Frenchboro Long Island Plantation, Hancock County; au-
thorized. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated
Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$35,000 to Long Island Plantation
for construction of a fire pond at Frenchboro, County of Hancock.

STATEMENT OF FACT

At present, there is a great need for a fire pond at Frenchboro Long Island
Plantation since there is no water supply should an emergency fire occur at
low tide. At high tide harbor water can be used.
