HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 803, L. D. 2297, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Use of Name of the State by Nonprofit Corporations."

Amend said Bill in the 8th line 2 times (7th and 8th lines in L. D.) by striking out the underlined words "Secretary of State" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'Attorney General'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 16th, 17th and 18th lines (15th and 16th lines of L. D.) the following:

"The Secretary of State may issue appropriate rules and regulations to administer this section."

Statement of Fact

This amendment places the responsiblity of approval of the name "Maine" under the Attorney General's Office inasmuch as the Attorney General's Office must pass on the purposes of corporations. This amendment also removes the sentence which states "The Secretary of State may issue appropriate rules and regulations to administer this section."
