STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR

AN ACT to Exempt Cigarettes under the Unfair Sales Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., T. 10, § 1202, sub-§ 2, ¶ D, repealed. Paragraph D of subsection 2 of section 1202 of Title 10 of the Revised Statutes is repealed.
- Sec. 2. R. S., T. 10, § 1202, sub-§ 9, repealed. Subsection 9 of section 1202 of Title 10 of the Revised Statutes is repealed.
- Sec. 3. R. S., T. 10, § 1203, sub-§ 10, additional. Section 1203 of Title 10 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 10 to read as follows:
- 10. Cigarettes. Where the merchandise advertised or offered for sale or sold is cigarettes.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this bill to exempt cigarettes under the Unfair Sales Act.
