COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 1818,
S. D. 2305, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the
Indebtedness of the Ogunquit Sewer District."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the
enacting clause, the following emergency preamble:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the
Legislature do not become effective until 90 days
after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the present sewer system of the
Ogunquit Sewer District is inadequate to provide
for the needs of the users and a more adequate
system must be immediately implemented; and

Whereas, an adequate sewer system is
essential to the health and well-being of the
people who are serviced by the Ogunquit Sewer
District; and

Whereas, it is imperative that action be
taken at the earliest possible time to eliminate
such conditions; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
these facts create an emergency within the meaning
of the Constitution of Maine and require the
following legislation as immediately necessary for
the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore, '

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the
end, before the Statement of Fact, the following
emergency clause:

(Filing No. H-669)

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to add an emergency preamble to the bill.
