**AN ACT Prohibiting a Municipal Officer from being a Member of the
Legislature.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2252-A, additional. Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2252-A to read as follows:

§ 2252-A. Municipal officers prohibited from being members
of the Legislature

No municipal officer, either elected or appointed, shall have a seat in either House of the Legislature during his being such municipal officer or his continuing in such office.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide that no municipal officer can be at the same time a Member of the Legislature.
