# STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR

# AN ACT Prohibiting a Municipal Officer from being a Member of the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2252-A, additional. Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2252-A to read as follows:

§ 2252-A. Municipal officers prohibited from being members of the Legislature

No municipal officer, either elected or appointed, shall have a seat in either House of the Legislature during his being such municipal officer or his continuing in such office.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide that no municipal officer can be at the same time a Member of the Legislature.
