HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 1836, L. D. 2327,
Bill, "AN ACT to Specifically Include Sundays in
the Seasonal Date Limitations for Hunting in
Commercial Shooting Areas."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the
Statement of Fact and inserting in place thereof
the following:

'Statement of Fact

The purpose of this bill is to make clear that
hunting for exotic game birds, specifically mallard
ducks, pheasants, quail and Chukar partridge is
permitted on commercial shooting areas , on
Sundays during the commercial hunting season.
Nothing in this bill shall be construed to permit
hunting for any other game or game birds on Sunday.'
