**AN ACT to Specifically Include Sundays in the Seasonal Date Limitations
for Hunting in Commercial Shooting Areas.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2475, amended. Section 2475 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 86 of the public laws of 1967, is amended to read as follows:

§ 2475. Hunting season

The annual season for commercial shooting areas shall extend from July 1st to November 30th, **including Sundays.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to make clear that hunting is permitted on Sundays during the hunting season.
