IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR

RESOLVE, Reimbursing Southern Aroostook Community School District for Loss by Fire.

Southern Aroostook Community School District; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$9,000 to be paid to the Southern Aroostook Community School District to reimburse said School District for loss by fire of school building, equipment and supplies.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The Southern Aroostook Community School District, consisting of the Towns of Crystal, Dyer Brook, Island Falls, Merrill, Oakfield and Smyrna, has lost a school building which housed grades 6, 7 and 8, 170 students in 8 classrooms. All desks and materials were lost in the fire. The building was an old hotel left to the Town of Oakfield by the B and A Railroad and was insured for \$22,000. The immediate problem is to purchase enough desks and materials to educate the students in the remaining school buildings on a double session basis. The units respectfully request \$9,000 from the State to help defray the expense of purchasing new desks and supplies. It is anticipated that a new facility will be available for these students sometime in the fall of 1975.
