SENATE AMENDMENT" B " H.P. 1857, L.D. 2350,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Power of the Commis-  
sioner of the Department of Transportation and the  
Chief of the Maine State Police to Lower Speed  
Limits in Order to Provide Energy Conservation."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end of  
the first paragraph after the enacting clause the  
following new sentence:

'The Secretary of State is directed to issue a  
regulation providing that there be no assessment of  
points, under any point system adopted by him,  
following a conviction for speeding where the speed  
is less than 10 miles per hour above the posted  
speed.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide  
that the livelihood of Maine people will not be  
affected as drastically as it now is.
