HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1844, L. D. 2351,
Bill, "AN ACT to Apportion the House of
Representatives."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of
section 8 and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'Sec. 8. The County of Lincoln shall choose
3 Representatives to be apportioned as follows:
Nobleboro, Waldoboro, Bremen, Jefferson,
Whitefield, Monhegan, 1 Representative; Bristol,
South Bristol, Damariscotta, Newcastle,
Boothbay, Alna, 1 Representative; Southport,
Boothbay Harbor, Wiscasset, Westport, Edgecomb,
Dresden, 1 Representative.'
