SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to S. P. 826, L. D. 2353, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify Certain Administrative Aspects of the Saco River Corridor Commission."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in the 11th line (10th line in L. D.) by inserting after the stricken out figures "1936" the underlined words 'at any time during'

Further amend said Bill in section 4 in the 6th line (5th line in L. D.) by striking out the underlined words and punctuation "a body corporate and politic,"

Further amend said Bill in section 4 by inserting at the end the following underlined sentence: 'Members and alternates shall not be personally liable for the official acts of the commission.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the Emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 8. R. S., T. 12, §4812, amended.  
The last paragraph of section 4812 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 535 of the public laws of 1971 and as repealed and replaced by section 3 of chapter 564 of the public laws of 1973, is amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read as follows:

Any or all areas within a municipality which are subject to nonmunicipal zoning controls may be exempted from the operation of this section upon a finding by the Bureau of Environmental Protection and the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission that the purposes of this chapter have been accomplished by such nonmunicipal zoning.'

This amendment is designed to clarify certain administrative aspects of the Saco River Corridor Commission relating to the conduct of hearings and to correct errors and omissions in the original legislation and to clarify its relationship to the Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 4812.
