HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" TO SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 832, L. D. 2375, Bill, "AN ACT Establishing the Office of Energy Resources."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the 3rd and 4th lines and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 2, §6, sub-§7, amended.
Subsection 7 of section 6 of Title 2 of the Revised'

Further amend said Amendment by inserting before the last paragraph the following:

'Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Executive Department, Office of Energy Resources, the sum of \$96,000 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:

Statement of Fact

The salary classification limitation for the Director of the Department of Energy Resources has been cut from \$18,000 per year to \$16,500 per year. The 5 employees allotted has been cut to 3 and the appropriation for "All Other" and "Capital Expenditures" have been reduced. Thus the total proposed appropriation of \$162,500 has been reduced to \$96,000.
