to S. P. 832, L. D. 2375, Bill, "AN ACT Establishing

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of  
the 3rd and 4th lines and inserting in place  
thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 2, §6, sub-§7, amended.  
Subsection 7 of section 6 of Title 2 of the Revised'

Further amend said Amendment by inserting  
before the last paragraph the following:

'Further amend said Bill by striking out  
all of section 2 and inserting in place thereof  
the following:

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated  
from the General Fund to the Executive Department,  
Office of Energy Resources, the sum of \$96,000  
to carry out the purposes of this Act. The break-  
down shall be as follows:

Statement of Fact

The salary classification limitation for the Director of the Department of Energy Resources has been cut from \$18,000 per year to \$16,500 per year. The 5 employees allotted has been cut to 3 and the appropriation for "All Other" and "Capital Expenditures" have been reduced. Thus the total proposed appropriation of \$162,500 has been reduced to \$96,000.
