Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the first 4 paragraphs.


Further amend said Amendment in the 5th paragraph by striking out in the first line the words "Further amend" and inserting in place thereof the word 'Amend'

Further amend said Amendment in the 6th paragraph by striking out in the 2nd and 3rd lines from the end the following: ", 2 representatives from the academic community and 2" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word and figure 'and 4'

Further amend said Amendment by striking out all of the last paragraph before the Statement of Fact.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment to the Senate amendment is to delete the part relating to subsection 6 of section 6 of Title 2; to eliminate 2 representatives from the academic public and provide for 4 representatives from the general public.
