STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR

AN ACT Relating to Fees for Inspection of Elevators.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 464, amended. The last sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 464 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 313 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

Fees for each required periodic inspection subsequent to the initial inspection shall be \$10 \$15.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This implements recommendation #I, Department of Manpower Affairs, in the Maine Management and Cost Survey Report. The bill makes the Boiler and Elevator Division of the Bureau of Labor and Industry self-supporting. The increased income would be \$12,500 annually. This recommendation was supported by the Governor in his special message to the 106th Legislature presented on January 10, 1974.
