COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 844,
L. D. 2385, Bill, "AN ACT Prohibiting Swimming
or Bathing in Mt. Zircon Reservoir, Blanchard
Reservoir and the Distribtuion or Pettengill
Reservoir, all in Rumford, Oxford County."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the
last sentence before the Emergency clause and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Any person found violating any provisions of
this law shall be punished by a fine of not
more than \$50.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make
sure that the court decides who gets the
money and not the water district.
