IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR

AN ACT Relating to Organizational Change in Department of Transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 23, § 4206, sub-§ 2, ¶ A, amended. Paragraph A of subsection 2 of section 4206 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 16 of chapter 593 of the public laws of 1971, is amended to read as follows:

A. Bureau of Administration Administrative Services;

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill implements Recommendation #2, Department of Transportation, in the Maine Management and Cost Survey Report. The bill renames the Bureau of Administration to the Bureau of Administrative Services.

The Governor supported this Recommendation in his Special Message to the 106th Legislature presented on January 10, 1974.
