COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1895, L. D. 2406, Bill, "AN ACT to Transfer Certain Unexpended Dedicated Funds at End of Fiscal Year."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following: 'AN ACT Relating to Certain Dedicated Funds.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 1-A. R. S., T. 5, §1664, amended.
The last paragraph of section 1664 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Part 3 shall embrace complete drafts or summaries of the budget bills, the legislative measures required to give legal sanction to the complete financial plan when adopted by the Legislature. These bills shall include General Fund appropriation bills and Special Revenue Fund allocation bills as may be needed to authorize all operating expenditures of the State Government for each fiscal year of the ensuing biennium. In addition thereto, these bills shall include such other bills as may be required to provide the income necessary to finance the budget.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make provision for Special Revenue Funds to be presented to the Legislature in the form of an allocation act similar to General Fund.
