RESOLVE, to Reimburse Edgar W. Tupper of Madison for
Loss of Beehives by Bear.

Edgar W. Tupper; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$2607.85 to be paid to Edgar W. Tupper of Madison as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for loss of beehives and honey destroyed by bear.

STATEMENT OF FACT
