AN ACT Transferring School Bus Driver Qualification Duties from Transportation and Safety, Department of Educational and Cultural Services, to Motor Vehicle Division.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 2013, amended. Section 2013 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

§ 2013. Physical examination of school bus operators

No person shall operate a school bus with a seating capacity of 10 or more persons in the actual conveyance of school children until he shall have passed such annual physical examination as the State Board of Education Motor Vehicle Division shall prescribe to determine his physical fitness.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to transfer the establishment of qualifications for school bus drivers from the Department of Educational and Cultural Services to the Motor Vehicle Division. It is in accord with and implements Recommendations 7 and 5, Department of Educational and Cultural Services of the Maine Management and Cost Survey Report and was approved for enactment by Governor Kenneth M. Curtis in his special message to the 106th Legislature dated January 10, 1974.
