AN ACT Repealing the Law Relating to Youth Community Activities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 34, §§ 251, 252 and 253, repealed. Sections 251, 252 and 253 of Title 34 of the Revised Statutes are repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill implements Recommendation No. 7, Department of Mental Health and Corrections, in the Maine Management and Cost Survey Report. It discontinues the position of coordinator of Youth Activities in the Department of Mental Health and Corrections. The Governor supported this recommendation in his Special Message to the 106th Legislature presented on January 10, 1974.
