HOUSE AMENDMENT" A " to S.P. 852, L.D. 2420,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Eliminate Collection of Delinquent  
Accounts by the Treasurer of State."

Amend said Bill in section 4 by striking out  
all of the last underlined sentence and inserting  
in place thereof the following:

'In cases of failure to pay, the department, in-  
stitution or agency shall refer the account to the  
Attorney General for collection.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to leave it  
to the discretion of the Attorney General whether  
or not to collect on accounts receivable.
