COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 872,
L. D. 2440, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Special
Agency Stores and Store Hours Under the
Liquor Laws."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out
in the 5th line (4th line of L.D.) the underlined
word "bureau" and inserting in place thereof the
underlined word 'commission'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by
striking out in the next to the last line
(same in L.D.) the underlined word "bureau"
and inserting in place thereof the underlined
word 'commission'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 in
the 9th line (same in L.D.) by striking out the
stricken out word "~~commission~~" and inserting in
place thereof the following word: 'commission'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 in
the 10th line (9th line of L.D.) by striking
out the underlined words "Bureau of Alcoholic
Beverages"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to place
authority for establishment of special stores and
regulations of store hours with the State Liquor
Commission rather than the Bureau of Alcoholic
Beverages.
