HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1920, L.D. 2452,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify Certain Municipal Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of  
section 8 and inserting in place thereof the  
following:

'Sec. 8. R.S., T. 22, §4502, amended. The  
first sentence of section 4502 of Title 22 of the  
Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 122 of  
chapter 625 of the public laws of 1973, is repealed  
and the following enacted in place thereof:

In any instance when it is proposed to terminate,  
suspend or reduce relief being provided, the  
recipient shall be given timely and advanced notice  
detailing the reasons for the proposed action and  
informing the recipient of his right to request an  
evidentiary hearing within 5 working days following  
receipt of the notice by the recipient, which  
evidentiary hearing shall be held within 30 working  
days of receipt of said request.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify  
the statutes with respect to fair hearings in  
welfare cases.
