HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to H. P. 1920, L. D. 2452, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify Certain Municipal Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 8 the following:

'Sec. 9. R. S., T. 29, §1368, sub-§1, amended. The first sentence of subsection 1 of section 1368 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Lights used on ambulances, fire department vehicles, vehicles operated by city and town fire inspectors, forestry department vehicles used for forest fire control purposes, and by vehicles operated by chiefs and **assistant chiefs officers** of fire departments shall emit a red beam of light.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 9 to 14 to be sections 10 to 15.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clear up the confusion that exists where some fire departments use such terms as deputy chief, captain and lieutenant to describe their officers.
