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**RESOLVE, Reimbursing the Town of Wade for Welfare Expenditures in  
Behalf of a Nonsettled State Case.**

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**Town of Wade; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$3,552.24 to be paid to the Town of Wade to reimburse the town for welfare expenditures in behalf of a nonsettled state case for the period from May, 1969 to June, 1972.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The above expenditures would have been reimbursed by the Department of Health and Welfare if municipal officers had submitted claims within a reasonable time after expenditures were made as required under the Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 4455. Municipal officials did not submit requests for reimbursement until April 12, 1973.
