AN ACT Repealing the Budget Laws Providing for Work Programs and Allotments.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 1667, repealed. Section 1667 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This legislation is related to the Maine Management and Cost Survey recommendation 24 and 25, Bureau of Budget. It repeals the section in the statutes that provides for work programs and allotments.

Governor Curtis recommended in his special message of January 10, 1974 that until a satisfactory monitoring system is developed this bill should be deferred for further study.
