COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1940,
L. D. 2477, Bill, "AN ACT relating to the Powers of
Hospital Administrative District No. 1 in Penobscot
County."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out
all of the first underlined sentence after the
amending clause and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'To procure funds for capital construction of and
equipment for projects reviewed and approved by
the appropriate regional and state health planning
agencies organized pursuant to the Revised
Statutes, Title 22, section 253, or any bodies
succeeding to such function, or for refunding
outstanding indebtedness created therefor, the
board of directors of said district is authorized,
by a vote of not less than a majority of all of
said directors, to borrow money from time to time
and to issue bonds in the name and on the full faith
and credit of the district.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require
the approval of state and regional health planning
agencies prior to the issuance of bonds for capital
construction.
