SENATE AMENDMENT "^B" to S.P. 888, L. D. 2484, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize the City of Lewiston to Issue \$500,000 Bonds for the Construction, Original Equipping and Furnishing of a District Courthouse and to Authorize the City to Lease such Courthouse to the District Court of the State."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following new Title: 'AN ACT to Authorize the Municipalities of this State to Issue Bonds for the Construction, Original Equipping and Furnishing of a District Courthouse for their Respective Districts and to Authorize Lease of the Same to the State.'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out in the first line the words "City of Lew ton is" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'municipalities of this State are'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by inserting in the 2nd line after the word "courthouse" the following: 'within their respective districts'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out in the 3rd line (2nd line of L.D.) the following: "not exceeding \$500,000"

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out in the first line the word "Such" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'Any such'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out in the first line the words "the city" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'such municipalities'

SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 888, L.D. 2484, P. 2.

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 3 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 3. The construction, original equipping and furnishing of any courthouse shall be carried out by such municipalities subject to the Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1741 to section 1750, provided that the 5% to be withheld from a contractor under section 1746 shall be withheld by the municipalities rather than the State.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 4.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to overcome the technical objections of the Attorney General's office, which objections pertained to one city being allowed to construct a District Court and lease it to the State of Maine.
