SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to S. P. 888, L. D. 2484, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize the City of Lewiston to Issue \$500,000 Bonds for the Construction, Original Equipping and Furnishing of a District Courthouse and to Authorize the City to Lease such Courthouse to the District Court of the State."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following:

'AN ACT to Authorize Municipalities of the State to Construct, Equip and Furnish a District Court within the Municipality and to Lease Same to the State.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 30, §5106, sub-§12, additional.  
Section 5106 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 12 to read as follows:

12. Constructing, equipping and furnishing a District courthouse within the municipality. A municipality may negotiate a lease with the Chief Judge of the District Court for a lease for the use of such a courthouse.'
