## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 106TH LEGISLATURE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 895, L. D. 2488, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Education Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 6 the following:

'Sec. 7. R. S., T. 20, §226, sub-§4, ¶A, amended. The first sentence of paragraph A of subsection 4 of section 226 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Each person whose name appears on the municipal voting list of the municipalities and-resides within-said-municipalities within the district may attend and vote at a district budget meeting.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 7 to 45 to be sections 8 to 46.

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to delete the residency requirement from the law.
