SENATE AMENDMENT" B "to S. P. 895, L.D. 2488, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Education Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 34 the following:

'Sec. 34-A. R.S., T. 20, §3713, sub-§3, ¶D, amended. Paragraph D of subsection 3 of section 3713 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 556 of the public laws of 1973, and as amended by section 52-D of chapter 571 of the public laws of 1973, is further amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

Whenever a unit, under special arrangement with the Federal Government, elects to educate pupils who reside on land under control of the Federal Government, and that unit has raised the maximum amount allowable under this Title for school purposes, and still has insufficient funds to operate its schools, that unit may apply to the State Board of Education for a subsidy adjustment. The State Board of Education may adjust the aid to the unit provided that such an adjustment when combined with federal dollars does not exceed the per pupil allocation computed for the resident pupils of that school unit. Such an adjustment shall be made only after complete documentation and justification has been submitted to the board.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to relieve hardships for units educating pupils who live on federal property.
