HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1955, L.D. 2490,
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Dredging, Filling or
Otherwise Altering of Rivers, Streams and Brooks."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by inserting at
the end of that part designated "§2207." the fol-
lowing new sentence:

'The commissioner may allow the commercial removal
of gravel from rivers and streams using the factor
of economics as well as environment.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow
that gravel is necessary for the economic development
of the State of Maine and the restriction on the use
of river gravel has been detrimental.
