

STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 106TH LEGISLATURE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "**A**" to H. P. 1962, L. D. 2502, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Reimbursement of Providers of Care and Treatment other than the State."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause, the following emergency preamble:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Counseling Center is not able to bill 3rd-party insurers because of technical and legal restraints; and

Whereas, the Bangor Mental Health Institute is a state facility, it cannot reimburse the Counseling Center for any percentage of the fees collected since the money must go back to the State General Fund, it is essential that this Act be passed as an emergency measure; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end of that part designated "<u>§2518.</u>" the following:

'However, this section shall not be construed as a limitation on compensation for providers of patient care and treatment or as a limitation on contractual arrangements between such providers and the State.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
