HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 1963, L. D. 2504, Bill, "AN ACT Providing for Maine Motor Vehicle Insurance Reform."

Amend said Bill in section 3 by inserting after that part designated "§2963." the following:

'§ 2963-A. Tort liability limitation

Tort liability under this / chapter shall not apply unless an injured person's costs of medical and hospital expenses equal or exceed \$500. For the purposes of this section, "costs of medical and hospital expenses" are defined as the reasonable value for necessary services rendered for medical, hospital, dental, surgical, ambulance, professional nursing and rehabilitation services, but exempting diagnostic x rays in excess of \$100.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that there must be a \$500 minimum of an injured person's costs of medical and hospital expenses before any suit can be brought.
