HOUSE AMENDMENT " C " to S. P. 905, L. D.
2508, Bill, "AN ACT Making Current Services
Appropriations from the General Fund and
Allocating Money from the Federal Revenue Sharing
Fund for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1975."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end
before the Emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 22. Women's Correctional Center.
In the event that the Women's Correctional
Center at Skowhegan is no longer utilized for
the purposes specified in the Revised Statutes,
Title 34, chapter 67, the land and the buildings
formerly utilized as the Women's Correctional
Center shall not be sold to any private individual
or corporation but shall be under the supervision
and direction of the Bureau of Parks and
Recreation for the use of the people of the State
of Maine.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide
that the land and buildings at the Women's
Correctional Center shall not be sold.
