HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1969, L. D. 2509,
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Statue, "The Maine
Lobsterman."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end before
the emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 3. State Museum Bureau. The State
Museum Bureau shall be authorized to procure
a bronze replica of "The Maine Lobsterman" for
public display within the Capitol area at
Augusta.

Sec. 4. Appropriation. \longleftrightarrow There is
appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of
the General Fund to the State Museum Bureau the
sum of \$8,000 to carry out the purposes of this
Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:

State Museum Bureau	
All Other	\$8,000'
