HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 908, L. D. 2512, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Hospitalization of the Mentally Ill."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out in the 7th line (same in L.D.) the underlined words "the sheriff is authorized to permit"

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by inserting in the 8th line (same in L.D.) after the underlined words "county jail" the following underlined words 'shall be allowed'

Further amend said Bill in section 6 by striking out in the 7th line of paragraph B of subsection 2 of that part designated "§2333." the underlined word "but" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'and'

Further amend said Bill in section 6 by inserting in the 8th line of paragraph B of subsection 2 of that part designated "§2333." after the underlined word "shall" the underlined word 'not'

Further amend said Bill in section 7 by striking out all of the next to the last sentence of paragraph B of subsection 2 of that part designated "§2333-A." and inserting in place thereof the following: 'In the computation of this time, the day of admission shall not be counted, and intermediate Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays shall not be counted.'
