HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to S. P. 910, L. D.  
2519, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Property Tax  
Exemption of Health Care Institutions."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the  
Title and inserting in place thereof the following  
new Title: 'AN ACT Relating to Property Tax  
Exemption of Health Care Institutions and  
Exempting Nonprofit Ambulance Service Vehicles  
from Excise Tax and Registration.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after  
the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 29, § 256, amended. The  
2nd paragraph of section 256 of Title 29 of the  
Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended  
by adding at the end a new sentence to read as  
follows:

All motor vehicles owned and used by a nonprofit  
ambulance service shall be exempt from the  
provisions of this Title as to registration fees,  
but shall not be exempt from the inspection  
requirements of section 2122.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the  
beginning of the first line after the enacting  
clause (same in L.D.) the underlined  
abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 2.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the  
end before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 3. R. S., T. 36, § 1483, sub-§ 3-A,  
additional. Section 1483 of Title 36 of the  
Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended  
by adding a new subsection 3-A, to read as  
follows:

3-A. Nonprofit ambulance service. Motor vehicles owned by a nonprofit ambulance service.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exempt vehicles owned by nonprofit ambulance services from excise tax and registration.
