HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to S. P. 911, L. D. 2521,
Bill, "AN ACT Repealing Certain Laws Relating to
Games of Chance."

Amend said Bill in section 3 by striking
out all of the first underlined sentence of
the 2nd paragraph of that part designated
"§339." and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'The fee for a license to operate a game of chance,
except a raffle, shall be \$5 for each week
computed on a Monday to Sunday basis, or portion
thereof, or such license may be issued for a
calendar month for a fee of \$20.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to reduce
the license fee to operate a game of chance
from \$25 to \$5 each week.
