SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 914, L. D. 2526, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify Certain Election Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 21, §361, sub-§1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 361 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 12 of chapter 414 of the public laws of 1973, is further amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

At the request of the municipal committee of a political party, municipal or town officers shall provide available space in a public building for a caucus.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 2 to 17 to be 3 to 18.

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to provide appropriate space for municipal caucuses in public buildings upon request of the municipal committees of political parties.
